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Treatment Guidelines
This guideline sets out an antimicrobial prescribing strategy for community-acquired pneumonia. It aims to optimise antibiotic use and reduce antibiotic resistance. During the COVID-19 pandemic: for children and young people, follow the recommendations in this guideline. for adults, follow the recommendations in the COVID-19 rapid guidelines on managing pneumonia in the community and pneumonia in hospital.

Community Acquired Pneumonia (CAP) - present on admission to hospital or developing within 48 hours of admission, or Hospital Acquired Pneumonia (HAP) - developing at least 48 hours after admission or within 7 days of discharge, although patients developing HAP <5 days after admission are likely to be infected by organisms similar to CAP and should be treated as CAP.

Management of Pneumonia - GGC
Medicines

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Initial treatment is with empirical antibiotics, following national/international guidelines and local epidemiology. In hospital, antibiotics should be administered within 4 hours of presentation. Sputum and blood samples should be sent for culture in people with moderate- or high-severity CAP, ideally before antibiotics are started, and legionella and pneumococcal urine antigen testing should be considered.

Community-acquired pneumonia (non COVID-19) - Symptoms ...

Patients with severe community-acquired pneumonia or who are admitted to the intensive care unit should be treated with a beta-lactam antibiotic, plus azithromycin or a respiratory fluoroquinolone.

Most outpatients with community-acquired pneumonia do not require microbiologic testing of sputum or blood and can be treated empirically with a macrolide, doxycycline, or a respiratory...

Key Points Community acquired pneumonia (CAP) can be diagnosed clinically when there are signs of a lower respiratory tract infection and wheezing syndromes have been ruled out CXR is not required for routine diagnosis or management, unless severe or complicated pneumonia is suspected
