Order of draw Take extra care when bleeding patients on anticoagulant therapy. They can bleed for a longer period after venepuncture and it is important to ensure that the venepuncture site has stopped bleeding. Apply the tourniquet 2-3 inches above the cubital fossa and palpate the area to find a suitable vein.

The acronym is Boys Love Ravishing Girls Like Dieters Love Greek Yogurt! Boys - Blood Culture Love - Light Blue Ravishing - Red Girls - Gold Like - Light Green

It also discusses what can happen when the order of draw is disregarded. Additive carryover occurs when the needle filling a tube comes in contact with the blood/additive mixture as the tube fills, and transfers a minute amount of blood and additive into the next tube filled. This can occur with both syringe and vacuum draws.
