Special Education Teaching vs. General Classroom Teaching. General education teachers and special education teachers share many of the same duties. In fact, they share many of the same students. This is because children with identified special needs often spend a portion of the day in the general education classroom and a portion of the day receiving more intensive services in a separate space.

Since general education and special education are two different and distinct areas of specialty, it's understandable that gaps in content knowledge may occur; for example, a general education teacher most likely won't have the same level of knowledge about individualized education plans (IEPs) as a special education teacher, and a special educator will likely not have the same level of understanding of subject matter pedagogy as a general education teacher.
