Just war theory is an area of political philosophy which addresses questions of morality and justice related to war and armed conflict. The module will focus on the three primary components of just war theory which are *ius ad bellum* (just before war), *ius in bello* (justice during war), and *ius post bellum* (justice in transitions from war to peace).
